Pharmacy Consultation and Technical Assistance Available from the Florida/Caribbean AETC

The recent implementation of the ADAP waiting list and the upcoming reductions in the medications listed in the ADAP formulary have left many Ryan White-funded programs around the state struggling to re-prioritize their spending so that patients can continue to receive the medications they need. Many of you are developing formularies or revising existing formularies in order to stretch your dollars to pay for as many medications as possible, for as many patients as possible. Prioritizing which medications to pay for will be necessary due to limitations in funding.

The Florida/Caribbean AETC is available to provide assistance to you as you work through this process. Our pharmacist faculty members can review the formularies that you develop or revise and provide input on which medications to include in the formulary, taking into account several factors including: 1) cost-effectiveness 2) drug-drug interactions and 3) availability of medications through pharmaceutical company patient assistance programs (PAPs).
