## **PHARMACY CHART REVIEWS**

The Florida/Caribbean AETC can conduct specialized chart reviews based on clinic, pharmacy, or agency needs. The focus of these reviews is to assure that:

- All medications are dispensed with appropriate drug, strength, quantity and directions.
- There are no inappropriate therapeutic duplication or significant drug-drug interactions.
- Allergies are listed in pharmacy system and consistent with allergies listed in the medical record.

Pharmacists can also conduct targeted reviews of medical records, focusing on suitability of drug therapy with respect to the patient's medical conditions, co-morbidities and concomitant medications (eg. Renal and/or hepatic dosing of medications, drug-drug interactions). During these types of reviews, the pharmacist will also evaluate antiretroviral regimens, laboratory monitoring and opportunistic infection prophylaxis to assure that DHHS Guidelines are being followed.
